## **Clarifications:**

**1. Does the successful prime contractor have to hold a Class “A” license?**

Yes.

**2. Will a Class C-12 license be accepted instead of an “A” for the prime contractor?**

No.

**3. Is this a public works project?**

Yes, so the successful contractor will be required to pay prevailing wages.

**4. What does “Request for Substitutions” mean?**

If a bidder wants to bid on something different than what ECCTA’s contract documents and drawings state, they must submit their request for substitution according to the process and timeline described in the bid documents.
